The ice show is a long-held tradition at the Cheam Skating Club that allows the skaters to showcase and perform what they have learned across the season for family, friends and the community. Skaters from every program, Canskate, Jr. Academy, CanPower, Starskate and Competitive have the opportunity to showcase their skills at the event of the season. Registration for Fall 2024 programming includes participation in the show, no additional registration is required.

What is the fee for the ice show?

What does the fee include?

The fee for the ice show includes a costume for your skater (that you get to keep) as well as helps pay for coaching, ice and decoration costs associated with the event.

For skaters in Star 1+, the cost covers one costume, additional costumes are an extra cost that is to be determined based on the number of routines your skater is in. Additional costs will be communicated at a later date. For this year's production of "Mario on Ice" we anticipate only one costume needed per skater due to way the show will be produced.





How does the ice show affect practice?

Canskate, Canpowerskate and Jr. Academy:

Programs are run as usual, there are no required times to attend skating other than the times that you are registered for (besides photo day, dress rehearsal and show day). Choreography is completed alongside learning; skaters will spend part of their session learning choreography and part of their session participating in their regular programming. Report cards are still distributed at the end of the season.

Starskate and Competitive:

Program scheduling will be adjusted from November 25 – December 12 to allow for choreography. Your skater may need to attend more session than usual for these 3 weeks. No buy-ons are required for extra days that your skater is required to attend. The coaches take into consideration the days of the week that skaters participate in when creating the schedule for choreography.

How can I help with the ice show?
